According to the annual ranking of Canada's Top 50 Research Colleges by Research Infosource Inc., Sheridan ranks in the top five research colleges in Canada.




Sheridan signs Indigenous Education Protocol

Marking a transformative moment in its history, Sheridan underscored its commitment to Truth and Reconciliation with the signing of the Indigenous Education Protocol.




Alumnus named to the Order of Canada
